Communications with Public and Press Policy
Adopted 9 February 2021

- 1 Meetings of Brimington Parish Council are advertised via the Parish Council website and via the notice board at the Community Centre
- 2 Members of the public and members of the press are welcome to attend any meeting of Brimington Parish Council and time is set aside for members of the public to raise any issues pertinent to the local area.
- 3 Any inquiries from the press will be dealt with, by the Clerk to the Council who will factually relay Council decisions. Councillors are permitted to speak to the press only as individuals and not members of the Council. A request for a comment from Brimington Parish Council should always be directed to the Clerk to the Council for a response.
- 4 Information about Council events and activities will be disseminated via the Council's official website and Facebook page by the Clerk to the Council. It may be deemed appropriate for the information to be disseminated via other means; again this is to be arranged by the Clerk to the Council and not by individual Councillors.
- 5 The Council Website and Facebook page intend to provide information and updates regarding activities and opportunities within the village and promote our community positively.

Communications must be civil, tasteful and relevant and not contain content that is knowingly unlawful, libellous, harassing, defamatory, abusive, threatening, harmful, obscene, profane, sexually oriented or racially offensive
