Please Note:

4 Public Speaking

Where a Member indicates they have a prejudicial interest, but wish to make representation regarding the item before leaving the meeting, those representations must be made under item (c) below. (If the item to which representations or comment were made by a Member is on the Agenda the Member must declare that interest again and withdraw from the meeting during consideration of that item)

(b) If the Police Liaison Officer, a County Council or Borough Council Member is in attendance they will be given the opportunity to raise any relevant matter. Members of the Council however will restrict Police matters they raise to those relating to Brimington Parish Council.

(c) Members declaring a pecuniary interest who wish to make representations or give evidence under the Code of Conduct relating to Agenda items shall do so at this stage.

If the Council decides to exclude the public it will be necessary to pass a resolution in the following terms: - "That in view of the confidential nature of the business about to be transacted in any other items which may be deemed confidential, it is advisable in the public interest, that the press and public be temporarily excluded and they are instructed to withdraw."
