Please Note:

4 Public Speaking

Where a Member indicates they have a prejudicial interest, but wish to make representation regarding the item before leaving the meeting, those representations must be made under item (c) below. (If the item to which representations or comment were made by a Member is on the Agenda the Member must declare that interest again and withdraw from the meeting during consideration of that item).

(b) If County Council or Borough Council Member is in attendance they will be given the opportunity to raise any relevant matter. Members of the Council however will restrict matters they raise to those relating to Brimington Parish Council.

(c) Members declaring a pecuniary interest who wish to make representations or give evidence under the Code of Conduct relating to Agenda items shall do so at this stage.
