(a) Crime Figures – October 2021

The Crime Figures for October 2021 are 92, compared to 60 for the same period in 2020 and 57 in 2019 and 46 in 2018. The crimes include 7 incidents of anti-social behaviour, 33 criminal damage, 32 violence, 3 public order, 3 theft of or from vehicle, 2 other theft, 4 burglary, 2 shoplifting, 3 drugs, 3 other crime.

The clerk reported that a representative of the Derbyshire Business Crime Reduction Partnership had visited the Centre, they have received a grant from the Police and Crime Commissioner and are working in the area to recruit businesses to the partnership. A follow up email has been sent to find more information.
