(a) Crime Figures

The Crime Figures for June 2021 are 84, compared to 74 for the same period in 2020 and 66 in 2019 and 39 in 2018. The crimes include 18 incidents of anti-social behaviour, 6 criminal damage,

43 violence, 3 public order, 2 theft of or from vehicle, 2 other theft, 4 burglary, 6 other crime, 1 robbery.

The Crime Figures for July 2021 are 79, compared to 85 for the same period in 2020 and 58 in 2019 and 50 in 2018. The crimes include 13 incidents of anti-social behaviour, 8 criminal damage, 37 violence, 5 public order, 3 theft of or from vehicle, 10 other theft, 1 burglary, 2 other crime.

It was discussed that the rise in crime is a real concern.
