(b) If County Council or Borough Council Member is in attendance they will be given the opportunity to raise any relevant matter. Members of the Council however will restrict matters they raise to those relating to Brimington Parish Council.

(c) Members declaring a pecuniary interest who wish to make representations or give evidence under the Code of Conduct relating to Agenda items shall do so at this stage.

(d) Visit from Remedi on the Derbyshire Immediate Justice Scheme - providing restorative activities for young people and adults including community clean ups
