The crime figures January 2025 show 32 reported crimes compared to 66 for the same period in 2024 and 45 in 2023 and 44 in 2022. These include 5 – Anti-Social Behaviour, 2 – Criminal Damage / Arson, 16 – Violence, 4 - Public Order, 1 – Other Theft, 2 – Other Crime, 2 – drugs.

The crime figures February 2025 show 51 reported crimes compared to 67 for the same period in 2024 and 44 in 2023 and 50 in 2022. These include 9 – Anti-Social Behaviour, 27 – Violence, 6 - Public Order, 2 – Theft of or from Vehicle, 5 – Other Theft, 1 – Other Crime, 1 – drugs.
